

## Hold Harmless Agreement for Membership/Volunteering at Gamble Creek Farm.

The staff of Gamble Creek Farm and Florida West Coast Resource Conservation and Development strive hard to create a hazard free environment, but members and volunteers should be aware of the naturally hazards of a farm including but not limited to: uneven land, fire ants and other insects, twine and stakes in the field and other equipment. The staff also relies on our members to help to report concerns to the farm manager or RC&D Staff. Members and volunteers will be provided orientation to its rules, facilities, usage of tools, and safety.

In consideration for becoming a member or volunteer at Gamble Creek Farm the member or volunteer releases Gamble Creek Farm and Florida West Coast Resource Conservation and Development, its board, employees from any claim for injuries and/or damages arising from or in any way relating to my participation in the Community Supported Agriculture program, Community Garden plot and tool use related to this participation. The member or volunteer will indemnify and hold harmless Gamble Creek Farm, Florida West Coast Resource Conservation and Development for all losses, damages, attorney's fees, costs or expenses resulting from any injuries or damages which may be suffered during participation as a member or volunteer at Gamble Creek Farm or other activities on this farm.

I understand my participation is entirely voluntary and PYO or volunteer works can involve moderate physical activity. I agree to participate at my own risk.

Children are welcome at the farm. Parental supervision is required at all times.
