



Tiny Green Thumbs Workshop

A 3-Day Program for parent and child to learn where their food comes from and how it is grown.

Day 1: Saturday, November 7– You and your child will be given a tour of the farm and meet the farmer. See how a field is prepared, how plants are started and experience planting both seeds in the greenhouse and seedlings in the field. Take home a plant and watch it grow.

Day 2: Saturday, February 27- The Children will witness the importance of watering weeding and feeding their plants. A BUG HUNT will take place to find beneficial and nuisance bugs.

Day 3: Saturday, April 24- The Children will see the fruits of their labor by picking a few veggies straight from the field and the wonders of eating fresh veggies. Children and parent will also have the opportunity to get their picture taken with the John Deere Tractor!!

The program is designed for ages 4-7 with one parent. It will be held at Gamble Creek Farm 14950 Golf Course Rd. Parrish, FL 34219 and is limited to 10 (parent and child duos)

This is a working farm so participants should dress appropriately. Shoes must be worn at all times, no sandals or any open toe shoes. There will be attendee participation so expect dirty hands and dirty clothes at the end of the program!!!
